A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TIM LALLY CHEVROLET, INC. TO PURCHASE A NEW 2021 CHEVROLET SILVERADO 3500 HD FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has advertised for bids for the purchase of a new one ton truck for the Fire Department, and

WHEREAS, the only bidder was Tim Lally Chevrolet, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Tim Lally Chevrolet, Inc. for the purchase of a new 2021 Chevrolet Silverado 3500 HD for \$ 55,717.00 for use by the Plymouth Fire Department.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the truck is available for purchase and is also needed by the Fire Department for brush fire fighting, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
