A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE CIVISTA BANK FINANCING FOR THE VILLAGE'S PURCHASE OF ITS NEW POLICE VEHICLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has purchased a new police vehicle under State of Ohio purchasing and has determined the best financing option without down payment is through Civista Bank.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the police vehicle purchase financing offered by Civista Bank for four (4) years without any down payment is accepted in the amount of \$ 37,782.10
2. THAT the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized to sign all necessary bank financing documents.
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason the Civista Bank financing is necessary to allow the Police Department to take delivery of the needed police vehicle and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
