A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE A GOVERNMENTAL OPIOID CLAIMANT PROOF OF CLAIM IN THE PENDING BANKRUPTCY CASE OF PURDUE PHARMA L.P., ET AL., CHAPTER 11, CASE NO. 19-23649 (RDD), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has been informed of its eligibility to file a Proof of Claim in the pending bankruptcy case of Purdue Pharma L.P., et al.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor is authorized to file a Governmental Opioid Claimant Proof of Claim with the United States Bankruptcy Court, Southern District of New York, in the case of *In re Purdue Pharma L.P., et al.*, Chapter 11, Case No. 19-23649 (RDD).
2. THAT the Proof of Claim adopts and uses the Government Plaintiff Fact Sheet submitted in the Ohio MDL, *In re National Opiate Litigation*, MDL No. 17-02804 (N.D. Ohio 2017).
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the Proof of Claim must be filed by no later than July 30, 2020, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
