A RESOLUTION TO CONFIRM THE APPOINTMENT OF JUSTIN HOFFMAN AS REGULAR PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has reported that Justin Hoffman has successfully completed his probationary period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the Mayor's appointment of Justin Hoffman as regular part-time police officer as of January 14, 2018 and is confirmed at the pay rate of \$10.85 per hour.
2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to confirm their appointments following the completion of their probationary periods and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
