A RESOLUTION TO CONFIRM THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR'S APPOINTMENT OF DANNY PARAMORE AND KIEL FRITZ TO THE POSITION OF FULL-TIME UTILITY WORKERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH,
COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Village Administrator's appointment of Danny Paramore and Kiel Fritz to the full-time position of Utility Workers is confirmed.
2. THAT the confirmation shall be contingent on their respective satisfactory passage of drug and physical examinations. Upon such approval, their duties shall commence April 2, 2018, 2018.
3. THAT the hourly compensation of each Utility Worker shall be Twelve Dollars (\$12.00).
4. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to fill vacancies in these positions, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
